Stanley first started showing dogs in the 1980s as a junior handler & it was in this activity that he was to begin a dedicated involvement in the canine world. He was twice Runner-Up Junior Handler of the Year & his repertoire as a handler spans across all Groups including Whippets at Crufts on 2 occasions. Under the "Egoiste" affix, he has bred & shown Champions in Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, Shih Tzu, Pekingese and Lhasa Apsos, some of whom are multiple Group and Best in Show winners. Among his judging assignments, he considers his Specialty Show appointments most memorable & meaningful. These include the Central Golden Retriever Club of New Zealand, Chihuahua Club of Victoria, Wellington Bulldog Club, Papillon Club of New Zealand, Canadian Lhasa Apso National Specialty, Pomeranian Club of British Columbia, etc. He is also extremely honoured to have been invited to judge the New Zealand National Junior Handler finals in 2007, the winner of which represented New Zealand at the International competition at Crufts in 2008. Besides Singapore, Stanley has also judged in Ireland, Thailand, the Philippines, Indonesia, Malaysia, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, India, China & Brazil.
